Projected Tour Cost

Cost of Tour: \$4,500*/per person

- * Rates are per person per double room, and include:
 - 9 nights 5-Star Hotel Accommodations.
 - ALL Meals.
 - ALL entrance fees to each site we visit.
 - 10 days of touring and sightseeing.
 - Deluxe Motor Coach Ground Transportation.
 - A biblically oriented licensed tour guide.
 - Headsets connecting tourists to guide.
 - ALL Fees, Tips and Taxes. You will NOT be asked or expected to tip anyone or make additional donations at various sites.

Single Supplement: \$2,222**

**If you prefer a single occupancy room, this cost would be in addition to the cost of the tour. Single supplements are limited to four.

Not Included in the Cost:

- Air travel.
- Ground travel from the airport to the first hotel, and from the last hotel back to the airport.
- Medical or personal insurance.



General Information

General Notes:

- 1. Our tour is limited to 50 people. Participants will be chosen as follows:
 - 1st: The Grove Bible Chapel Members
 - 2nd: Family Members Traveling with The Grove Bible Chapel Members
 - 3rd: The Grove Bible Chapel Regular Attendees
 - 4th: Friends outside our church

If there was no room available for you this trip, your check will be returned to you.

- 2. The trip will be limited to those 18 years old and above or high school students accompanied by a parent.
- 3. Israel has a rugged terrain and temperatures can reach into the high 90s. All participants must be able to walk uphill at least one mile in hot temperatures.
- 4. A completed Tour Application and a <u>non-refundable</u> deposit of \$500 per person is required to hold your spot.
- 5. The balance of the tour cost is due as follows: \$2,000 by January 15th, and balance remaining by March 15th. Please note: all deposits are <u>non-refundable</u>.

Passport and Visa Information:

- 1. Your passport needs to be current with an expiration date six months <u>past</u> the date of return of April 20, 2026.
- 2. Your passport must have at least one blank page.
- 3. As of January 01, 2025, all visitors entering or transiting Israel must hold a valid visa or an approved ETA-IL for details: https://www.gov.il/en/departments/topics/eta-il/govil-landing-page



Immunizations and Health Information:

- 1. For immunization requirements and recommendations, visit: https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/non/israel
 - Your doctor or the health department can help you decide which vaccines and medicines are needed before traveling to Israel. The cost of immunizations is not included in the tour cost. These costs would be solely your responsibility.
- 2. Be sure to bring with you all necessary medications.
- 3. We recommend, if your doctor will allow, that each person bring along a prescription of Cipro (for food-born illnesses) and a general anti-biotic, like azithromycin (for infection), to have on hand in the case of sickness. Medical care is available, in the case of any emergency, but having these prescriptions with you may eliminate the need to miss a day of touring.
- 4. Tap water is reported to be safe in Israel.

Travel Advisory:

- 1. Although we are planning as safe a trip as possible, please understand that whenever you are traveling internationally, these is always the possibility of the unexpected. Please keep this in mind as you prepare to travel.
